











NEW RECYCLABLE ITEMS	NEWSPAPERS MAGAZINES CATALOGS PHONE BOOKS 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Place newspapers, magazines and catalogs in paper grocery bags if possible. Keep paper in bottom of green box. 	ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Napkins, tissue paper, paper towels, wax paper or wrapping paper. DO NOT USE STRING OR PLASTIC BAGS. NO OTHER PAPER PRODUCTS 	
	CORRUGATED CARDBOARD <i>Disassemble & flatten.</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Heavy paper items used for packaging, mailing or shipping. Corrugated cardboard has 2 outer layers of heavy paper with a ribbed section in the middle. Disassemble & flatten. 2' X 2' sections. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Disassemble, flatten and stack neatly. Set next to other recyclables. Keep clean and dry. No pieces larger than 2' x 2'. 	ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pizza boxes or any other cardboard contaminated with food. Wax coated cardboard. Oil stained cardboard. Wet or dirty boxes, yellowish "FOREIGN" cardboard.
NEW RECYCLABLE ITEMS	JUNK MAIL 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Place junk mail in paper grocery bag. Place bag on top of or next to green box. Keep from blowing out of bin. 	ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plastic envelopes. Plastic wrapping or tape. Carbon paper. DO NOT use plastic bags or place out loose. 	
	BOX BOARD <i>Disassemble & flatten.</i> 	Lightweight Cardboard <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dry food boxes, cereal, cookies, snacks, macaroni boxes. Non-food boxes. healthcare, gift boxes, paper product tubes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remove wax paper and plastic liners. Remove all styrofoam packing. Disassemble and flatten. Place in paper grocery bag. Please keep clean and dry. 	ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any food soiled cardboard. Frozen food & microwave containers. Egg cartons. Alcohol or beverage cases. DO NOT use Plastic bags or place out loose
	GABLE-TOP CONTAINERS <i>Rinse thoroughly.</i> 	Gable-top Containers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Milk cartons. Juice cartons. Individual drink boxes. Place loose in green box with other containers. 	Cartons <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rinse cartons thoroughly and drain. Cartons with plastic spouts; remove lids. Individual drink boxes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remove straw. Drain all liquid content. 	ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Straws from drink boxes. Individual drink pouches. DO NOT place in plastic bags. OPEN GABLE-TOP IF POSSIBLE DO NOT mix cartons with newspapers or cardboard.
NEW RECYCLABLE ITEMS	GLASS BOTTLES <i>Rinse thoroughly.</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All clear, green and brown food & beverage containers.   <p>PLACE LOOSE IN GREEN BOX</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rinse containers thoroughly. Remove lids & caps. Labels DO NOT have to be removed. Place loose in green box with other containers. 	ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ceramic bottles and other ceramic items, flower pots, crystal, light bulbs, mirror & window glass, heat resistant ovenware, hypodermic syringes or eye glasses. DO NOT BREAK GLASS.
	METAL CANS <i>Rinse thoroughly. Do NOT place in plastic bags</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All metal food & beverage containers (cans). EMPTY pet food cans. Metal lids, closures & caps. Empty aerosol cans 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rinse containers thoroughly. Labels DO NOT have to be removed. Place loose in green box with other containers. 	ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Propane cylinders, silverware, metal/cardboard containers (frozen juice, motor oil), small appliances, metal cookware, tin foil, hypodermic needles or paint cans. DO NOT INCLUDE ANY TYPE BATTERY
NEW RECYCLABLE ITEMS	PLASTIC <i>Rinse thoroughly.</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Only small mouth bottles, food, soap and beverage containers, with threaded cap. Look on the bottom of the container for recycling symbols.  <p>"Small mouth with threaded cap only." PLACE LOOSE IN GREEN BOX</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rinse thoroughly and drain. Labels DO NOT have to be removed. Only small necked containers with recycling symbols. EXAMPLES: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Milk & water jugs. Juice & all beverage bottles. Soap & detergent bottles. Ketchup & salad dressing. SOME EXCEPTIONS: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Peanut butter & jelly jars. Pickles & relish jars, etc. 	ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any plastic container other than small mouth regardless of symbol on bottom are NOT RECYCLABLE AT THIS TIME. NO WIDE MOUTH CONTAINERS Such as: yogurt, cottage cheese, margarine and "baby wipes" tubs, motor oil containers, etc. No microwave trays. NO plastic bags, furniture, plates, tableware, medicine bottles, plexiglass, fast food containers, snack bags or Tupperware. EVEN IF LABELED WITH SYMBOL NO polystyrene (styrofoam).

PLEASE—NO PLASTIC BAGS

PLEASE PLACE IN SAME CONTAINER



Place clean glass, metal and plastic containers and milk cartons in the green box together.

Place newspapers, magazines, lightweight cardboard and junk mail in paper grocery bags or in the bottom of recycling bin.

Place green box and paper cardboard items neatly stacked at the curb by 7:00 am on your regular garbage collection day.

GARBAGE, YARD WASTE, AND RECYCLABLES

- All materials must be placed at the curb by **7:00 AM** on your scheduled collection day.
- NO materials shall be placed at the curb before 6:00 PM on the day before your collection day. Garbage shall be placed in a Village issued tote container with lid closed.

TRASH

- Carpet, carpet padding, pool liners, and pool covers must be cut in **4 foot widths**, rolled, and tied, not to exceed 65 pounds.
- Fences, plasterboard, drywall, paneling and doors not to exceed **4' x 4' sections**. All smaller materials must be securely bundled not to exceed 4 feet in length or 60 pounds.
- Furniture, windows, scrap lumber (with nails bent down or removed no longer than 4 feet and bundled), bedding, window glass, and mirrors shall be placed at the curb.
- **Debris from any contracted work done on your property must be disposed of by the contractor.**

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

- **NEW YEAR'S DAY, MEMORIAL DAY, INDEPENDENCE DAY, LABOR DAY, THANKSGIVING DAY, AND CHRISTMAS DAY.** If your scheduled pick up falls on or follows any of the above holidays, your pick up will be delayed one day.

BRUSH AND YARD WASTE

- Small brush, hedge and tree clippings (under 2 feet), grass clippings and vines must be containerized or bundled, or in a Village issued tote container with lid closed.

PAINT, LATEX

- In original containers in a SOLID FORM by using oil-dry products, kitty litter, sand or air dry and place in garbage, with lids removed. Oil base paints contact Erie County Hazardous Waste.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Pesticides, pool chemicals, paint thinners, oil based paints, lead batteries, flammable materials and flammable liquids, etc. WILL NOT BE COLLECTED. Please call **ERIE COUNTY HAZARDOUS WASTE** at **858-6800** for disposal.

METAL & OTHER DEBRIS

The Village DPW will pickup the following items.

Pickup is 2nd and 4th Mondays, March thru October only. Pickups November thru February are on Fridays by appointment only, through the Village office. Put items out before 7 AM on Monday.

LARGE APPLIANCES - WHITE GOODS

- Washers, dryers, dishwashers, hot water tanks, refrigerators, freezers or air conditioners (door and freon removed), empty propane tanks, etc. No metal objects shall exceed 8 feet in length.

TREE BRANCHES & TRIMMINGS

- Tree branches & Trimmings not to exceed 6 feet in length or 4 inches in diameter. Must be piled with butt end in same direction. Branches, etc. must be placed between curb and sidewalk.

LOGS, CONCRETE ETC.

- Large logs, tree stumps, broken concrete, bricks, RR ties shall be placed between curb and sidewalk for pickup.

LEAF COLLECTION

- Leaves in the FALL ONLY, can be raked up and placed BETWEEN the curb and sidewalk for pick up.

TIRES

- Tires must be brought to the DPW, 40 S. Long Street between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. Current charge is \$2.00 per tire.
